## Letter from the Chairman

Dear Members,

As mentioned elsewhere in the magazine, the next World Conference is being held in Sri Lanka in March 2007 and I do hope to meet many of you there.

## Obituary

### Mr Derek James Finch CText ATI

Mr Finch CText ATI sadly died on 16 May 2006 after a long illness. He joined The Textile Institute in January 1969 when he was awarded his LTI and he then attained a CText ATI in 1987.

Mr Finch is survived by his wife Mrs Enid Finch who has provided the following obituary.

One of Mr Finch's proudest days was being awarded the CText ATI, which was richly deserved. His whole working life was involved in the testing of textiles, comprising 51 years in all, and was regarded as an expert in many areas.

Mr Finch started working for the Retail Trading Standards Association in Henley, moving to Alperston in Wembley when it became the London Textile House, and later SGS.


His expertise ranged from physical to composition testing in which his knowledge was unrivalled, especially in the field of natural fibres.

When he retired from SGS in 1988, he worked as a textile consultant for a further nine years and only stopped due to ill health when he was 67. Many of his clients kept in touch due to their admiration and affection for him. His whole attitude to his work was based on complete accuracy, attention to detail, a quest for excellence, which never allowed short cuts, and selfless dedication to finding the right answers.

Added to this was his own inimitable sense of humour, which endeared him to working colleagues and clients. I was always immensely proud of him and although my personal loss is grievous in the extreme, nothing will ever dim my pride in all his achievements.
